Stakeholder meeting on Competition and Choice in the UK Audit Market

The Financial Reporting Council is to hold a Stakeholder meeting following the publication of the report of a study jointly commissioned by the FRC and the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), "Competition and Choice in the UK audit market". The meeting takes place at the Jarvis Suite, Royal Institute of British Architects on 26 April 2006 starting at 4pm.

The study, conducted by economic consultancy Oxera, considers the factors that contribute to the competitive environment for audit services to large listed companies in the UK. Details are available at <http://www.frc.org.uk/press/pub1083.html>.

Oxera will present key findings from their study. Participants at the meeting will then have an opportunity to put questions to the Oxera team and to give their preliminary reactions to the report.

This meeting forms the first stage of a wider consultation by the FRC into the public interest issues that may arise from the existing competitive environment for audit services to large listed companies in the UK and how these issues might be addressed.
