My responses to the Questions posed on the above consultation paper are as follows:

Q1 - The process proposed before publishing high-level reports on individual firms appears reasonable. Will the firms comments be included within the published report?

Q2 - The proposed process are appropriate, although it would be useful to inform firms through either the FRC's email notifications or direct to the firm that the annual list has been published.

Q3 - Agreed.

Q4 - I agree that the benefits of transparency will probably outweigh the expected costs but feel that the increased costs look overstated given that the extra reporting will be based on work already carried out and processes should reduce the impact. Savings associated with removing the separate AIU annual report have been ignored.
