The Financial Reporting Council

- Having considered in the case of the Association of Authorised Public Accountants (AAPA) whether the requirements of Parts 2 and 3 of Schedule 10 of the Act are satisfied; and
- Having concluded that those requirements are not satisfied and that the AAPA consents to the revocation of its recognition as a supervisory body for statutory audit;

Orders under Paragraph 3, Schedule 10 of the Act that the recognition order of the AAPA is revoked. This Revocation Order will take effect on 31 December 2016.
